### To Enter:

1. **Complete on-line Contestant Resume** on the MCP website

2. **Submit entry fee** in-person to the Manatee County Fair Office at 1303 13<sup>th</sup> St. W., Palmetto by 5 PM on Friday, Dec. 22, **or** bring to the Orientation Meeting on Dec. 3, 2022.
  - Make Checks payable to the **Manatee River Fair Association** (cash or money order also accepted). No entries (paperwork or fees) will be accepted after the Orientation meeting on Dec. 3, 2022.
3. **Attend the Orientation meeting on Saturday, Dec. 3, 2022.** Orientation is not required for contestants to compete, however, due to the content of the meeting, Orientation is strongly recommended for all contestants.

## Mini, Little, Junior & Miss Divisions

### Contestants must meet the following requirements and rules as stated.

All contestants must be physically able and will participate without limitation in all Fair Pageant and Fair activities. Contestants must be of good moral character and never been convicted of a crime or have charges pending. All contestants must be childless, never have been married, or had a marriage annulled. Competition is only open to females in the following age divisions: Mini Miss Division, 7 - 9 years old; Little Miss division, 10 - 12 years old; Junior Miss division, 13 - 16 years old; Miss division, 17 - 22 years old. Contestants must be a Manatee County resident and within their age category limits as of Dec. 10, 2022.

### Competition Criteria:

Judges will select winners from the following criteria (all attire must be no higher than approximate knee length):

- In-person interview with judging panel
- On-Stage Question
- Western Wear
- Formal Wear (no hats or gloves).
